COMMON SEAL

SEA BUCKTHORN

Can grow in and adapt to extreme climates and difficult soils

HAWTHORN



The fruit, or haw, provide important winter food for birds.

SAND SEDGE



Helps to stabilise the dunes, helping other plants to grow.

BLACKTHORN



In winter, the twigs are black and spiny with leaf buds along the spines.
