## RAZORBILL

## BLACKTHORN



In winter, the twigs are black and spiny with leaf buds along the spines.

## ALDER



The wood of this tough tree doesn't rot when waterlogged!

## MARRAM GRASS



The matted roots help to stabilise sand dunes, helping other plants to grow.

## GORSE

## COMMON SEAL
