CORMORANT



Catches fish with their hook-tipped bills while swimming underwater.

ROWAN



Grows well at high altitudes and its leaves are similar to ash.

COMMON CORD GRASS



Turns from green/yellow to light brown in autumn and winter.

SAND SEDGE



Helps to stabilise the dunes, helping other plants to grow.

GORSE



Flowers from January to June (but it may flower sporadically throughout the year).

OYSTERCATCHER



These black and white birds have long orange-red bills and reddish-pink legs.
