HOW TO MAKE A DIY WILD DIY NATURE CROWN

Nature crowns made from twigs, leaves and flowers are a fun and easy way to get creative, spend time outdoors in nature and bring a little wildness inside.

They're a great alternative to a non-uniform Wear it Wild and can be done as a classroom activity. They can also help teach children the 3 R's - REUSE, REDUCE, RECYCLE!



- Durable cardboard you could use an old cereal box
- Nature materials e.g. sticks, leaves, flowers etc.
- Scissors
- Glue

HOW TO MAKE A CARDBOARD NATURE CROWN:

- 1. On the walk home from school, when you're out in nature or simply in your garden, gather up leaves, flowers, sticks and other natural elements.
- 2. Cut a piece of cardboard about 3" in width. Measure your child's head for the length and cut your cardboard strips accordingly.
- 3. Lay the cardboard flat and begin designing your crown. Take into consideration the items you are gluing.
- 4. Next, take your natural elements and glue them to your crown. If your kids are old enough, let them do this on their own..
- 5. When you are done designing your crown, glue the ends together.
- 6. Wear your crown with pride!
